

16 to 19 Tuition Fund

As required by the ESFA and detailed in their document 16-19 Tuition Fund, this statement explains how we will use the 16-19 Tuition Funding in line with the ESFA guidance to prioritise support for disadvantaged learners.

Bosco has received £18 073.00 from the 16 to 19 Tuition Fund. This funding has being provided to support small group tuition for 16 to 19 students in English, maths and other courses where learning has been disrupted. It will be used to employ a part time Functional skills tutor for the 2020-21 academic year. Lessons delivered by this tutor will be outside of study programme guided learning hours or support provided through EHCP funding.

Supported students will not have achieved a grade 4 in either English and maths by the age of 16. All supported students need to be on a study programme.

We will initially target those students who returned for Bosco for a second academic year who failed to achieve at least level 1 in both English and maths by the end of their first year.

Support will be offered to groups of no more than three students and will deliver coaching in generic study skills and intensive preparation for external examinations.

Working with English and maths tutors students will be identified and offered an intensive package of support through additional small classes in the four weeks leading up until sitting the external examination.
